IMPORTANT COMPLIANCE INFORMATION

Eye wash equipment should be provided where there is a risk of hazardous chemicals or infectious substances causing eye injuries.

Immediate access should be provided to shower equipment in workplaces where there is a risk of:

- Exposure to hazardous chemicals resulting in skin absorption or contamination from infectious substances
- Serious burns to a large area of the face or body (including chemical or electrical burns or burns that are deep, in sensitive areas or greater than a 20 cent piece)

Vehicles transporting Dangerous Goods (specifically Placard class, 2.3, 3, 4, 5.1 (Solids), 5.1 (Liquids), 5.2, 6.1, 8, 9) must have an eyewash kit at least 250ml capacity, filled and ready for use at all times.

BURN MANAGEMENT PACKS

- ▶ Early intervention to cool and treat burns can help reduce the severity of the injury. Workplace hazards that may result in burn injuries need to have burn management solutions readily available to reduce delays in first aid treatment. Cool water availability is of paramount importance. As a supplement, or where water is not readily available Australian Resuscitation Council guidelines make provision for the use of hydrogel as an acceptable treatment alternative.

Our Burn Management Packs provide suitable burn treatment products for emergency situations.

IMPORTANT COMPLIANCE INFORMATION

First aiders should take standard precautions to avoid becoming ill and exposing others to illness when handling blood or body substances. Standard precautions include hand hygiene, use of personal protective equipment, appropriate handling and disposal of sharps and waste, cleaning techniques and managing spills of blood and body substance.

CONTAMINATED ITEMS

All items that are soiled with blood or body substances should be placed in plastic bags and tied securely. Waste disposal should comply with any state or local government requirements.

Sharps, including scissors and tweezers that have become contaminated with blood or body substances should be disposed of in a rigid-walled puncture-resistant sharps container by the person that used them. Guidance on the design, construction, colour and markings of sharps containers is provided in:

- AS 4031 – Non-reusable containers for the collection of sharp medical items used in health care areas
- AS/NZS 4261 – Reusable containers for the collection of sharp items used in human and animal medical applications
